

SOCIETIES ACT
SCHEDULE “A”
CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is: “Southern Alberta Academy of Chefs” (S.A.A.C.) and/or “Canadian Culinary Federation Lethbridge” (C.C.F. Lethbridge).
2. The mandate of the C.C.F.C.C. and the Southern Alberta Academy of Chefs:
 - a. The advancement of the general interests of the profession of Chefs, including improvement in preparation, cooking and dispensing of all foods and the serving thereof.
 - b. To further any interests for the mutual benefit to the members of the Federation.
 - c. To increase the opportunities for youth to train in the culinary profession.
 - d. To stimulate public interest in the scientific preparation and serving of foods.
 - e. To promulgate its code of ethics.
3. The operations of the society are to be carried on only in the Province of Alberta, with its principal office in the City of Lethbridge.
4. It shall be a requirement of membership in the Southern Alberta Academy of Chefs/C.C.F. Lethbridge, that each member adopt the following Code of Ethics:

Section 1

- 4.01 I hereby embrace this Code of Ethics as laid by the Canadian Culinary Federation and I certify that I shall abide by the Constitution of this society and generally uphold the dignity of my profession and the C.C.F.

Section 2

- 4.02 I shall place honour and the standing of our profession before personal advantage.

Section 3

- 4.03 I shall not use unfair means to gain professional advancement or to injure the chance of another colleague to secure or hold employment.

Section 4

- 4.04 I shall at all times conduct myself so as not to bring discredit to, or dishonour upon the Canadian Culinary Federation.
